CHIEF MINE ENGINEER

Reporting to the Mine Manager, the Chief Mine Engineer (CME) will be responsible for overseeing activities related to supporting the operations and to ensure engineering and operating standards are met. The CME will be accountable for the delivery of all technical services for the mine and will develop and maintain optimal short- and long-term business plans.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The successful candidate will:

- Provide leadership for the safe and sustainable development of the mining operations;
- Ensure designs comply with all health and safety requirements;
- Supervise and mentor staff responsible for short and long term mine planning and all technical services related to the operation;
- Coordinate and align operations to the short and long range plan;
- Responsible for the achievement of the production and profitability objectives;
- Ensure the timely delivery of detailed layouts, plans and schedules;
- Lead the activities and resources to compile accurate mine budgets and cost forecasts;
- Accountable for having mine systems and infrastructure properly designed, installed, and maintained for the mine. These include development, blast design, ventilation, dewatering and backfill;
- Ensure that a comprehensive ground control strategy is in place and is implemented for the mine;
- Assess the feasibility and the potential for commercial benefits of new sites;
- Monitor and evaluate mine performance;
- Manage construction projects;
- Plan and implement extraction systems.
